Instalacja „Kopciuch”

W ramach projektu „Play Green with Us – Graj z nami w zielone!” uczniowie i nauczyciele przygotowali wspólną instalację artystyczną „Kopciuch”, która powstała jako finał działań mobilności realizowanej w Polsce. Stary piec, ustawiony na dziedzińcu szkoły, został przekształcony w rzeźbę i ozdobiony folią aluminiową oraz elementami przypominającymi ludzką twarz. Instalacja była symbolicznym protestem przeciwko spalaniu węgla i odpadów w domowych piecach i miała na celu zwrócenie uwagi lokalnej społeczności na problem zanieczyszczenia powietrza. Działanie to łączyło edukację ekologiczną z ekspresją artystyczną, angażując uczniów w aktywne działania prośrodowiskowe.

Installation “Kopciuch”

As part of the project *Play Green with Us – Play Green with Us!*, students and teachers created a collaborative art installation called “Kopciuch,” which served as the culmination of mobility activities carried out in Poland. An old stove, placed in the school courtyard, was transformed into a sculpture and decorated with aluminium foil and elements resembling a human face. The installation acted as a symbolic protest against burning coal and waste in domestic stoves, aiming to raise awareness among the local community about air pollution. This

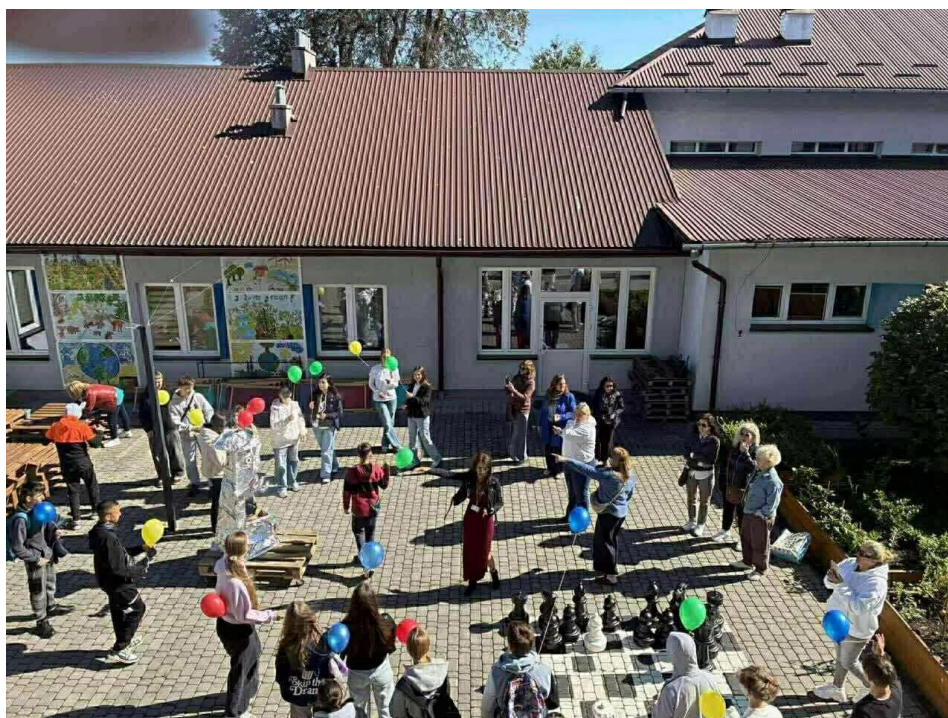
